


GENERAL INFORMATION IFSS race rules apply

THE ENTRY FORM IS FOR 1 ENTRY ONLY. Separate forms are required for different drivers in the same team.

Scott's Ferry Site, with its restored barge, is a rare reminder of the importance ferries played in New Zealand in the days before bridges were common. Prior to the introduction of a coach service in the 1870s, the main route from Wellington north to Wanganui and beyond was around the coastline. Today, Scott's Ferry Site is a rare memorial to a form of transport that was common in New Zealand in the nineteenth century. It is also associated with Thomas Scott, a notable figure in the history of the Rangitikei region.. Within easy commuting distance from New Zealand's Capital city Wellington, and from nearby Palmerston North.

The Scott's Ferry community is within a 10 minutes easy drive to Bulls should you need any supplies and food and drinks.

Race Information

Classes offered contribute toward both the IFSS accreditation and the NZFSS points system.

All events are run under IFSS Rules and Regulations

You don't need to be registered with IFSS (DID) to compete in the event, but only registered teams earn points towards the World cup program. Similarly, only NZFSS registered teams qualify for national points. A minimum of 3 entries is needed to open any class. Mushers will be notified if a class is not available and alternative classes will be suggested.

Important Notice for NZFSS Award Bootie Blowout & Black Hawk Classic are 2 events held as ONE NZFSS sanctioning (2 heats)

Finally... some important points!

- Good Sportsmanship should always prevail
- As always, the Race Judge/Marshall's decisions are final
- Safety helmets are compulsory for all classes, except Canicross
- It is the responsibility of the musher to ensure all equipment meets IFSS Regulations.
- A neckline for the 2-dog scooter class is mandatory
- Drivers' meeting is compulsory
- Class changes for sanctioned events, after entries have been accepted, must be accompanied by "just cause" and must be presented to the Race Judge/Marshall before the Mushers' Meeting. The Race Judge/Marshall's decision will be final.
- All Accredited/sanctioned classes may only be run if there are three (3) or more entries received by the official closing date. In case of insufficient entries for any given class, mushers who have entered for that class will be contacted regarding alternative options.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- All dug holes in the parking lot or accommodation venue are to be filled in, and all dog left-overs disposed of appropriately; rubbish bags/bins will be available
- All dogs must have been vaccinated and be free of infectious disease. Please ensure that vaccination certificates for all dogs are brought to the race – these will be checked by the race judge/vet. Dogs that are not fully vaccinated will not be eligible to race. Please get in touch with the Race Judge if you have any question regarding vaccinations.
- Cancellations: Refunds are at the discretion of the RGO. Please refer to the RR race weekend FB page for further information.
- Late entries are at the discretion of the Race Secretary .
- No Smoking, no Vaping, no Alcohol and no Open Fires! Please respect the Forest and appreciate that any infringements will jeopardize our future use of this fabulous venue
